How to play


For 3-4 players:
Shuffle the cards and deal them out to each player until the deck is finished. The aim of the game is to complete the most sets of four matching cards. The starting player can ask any other player for any card they need to make up a set (for instance, on her go Georgia might say: 'Omar, have you got any "foods" cards?'). If Omar does have such a card, he must pass it over If he doesn't have the card, he'll say "minime!" and the turn ends for Georgia. If Georgia does receive the card she asked for, she can continue to ask for other cards until she gets told "minime!". Whenever a player completes a set of 4 , they put this on the table in front of them. The winner is the child with the most sets at the end of the game.

For 2 players:
Deal out 8 cards to each player, and leave the rest in a face down shuffled deck. Whenever a player asks for a wrong card, they get to pick up a new card from the deck before the turn passes.
