Chapters 1 & 2 Vocabulary Squares

Vocabulary squares

• This activity reviews the **Vocabulary for learning** for both the current chapter and the previous chapter.

- It can be used with students organized into small groups, in pairs, or individually.
- Print out as many copies of the grid as you have groups, pairs, or individual students.
- Using a guillotine, cut each grid into 24 squares. (Use a paperclip or small envelope or bag to keep each set of 24 squares together.)
- Give each group/pair/individual one set of 24 squares.
- The students compete (against either each other or the clock) to recreate the grid by matching the Latin words with their meanings.
- The words around the outside of the grid are decoys.
- Project the full grid to the class at the end of the activity, so they can check their answers.
